# Pathways to Partnerships (Mumma Doris Shillingsworth)



The partnership pathway is informed from a Relationally Responsive Standpoint.

**Respect:** Ensure respect for, and celebration of, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander

ways of being, knowing, and doing.

**Connect:** Build a two-way appreciation of connecting founded on diversity, equity,

openness, mutual benefit, and courage.

**Reflect:** Take time to think and yarn with your collaborating organisation. Together,

shape and refine what you might do to address the issue/s identified.

**Direct:** Finally, you'll act on the new and shared knowledge refined through the

Reflect phase, in ways that are negotiated by all.

### **Transform Partnership Initiative - Flowchart**





High Achieving Indigenous organisations are invited to complete a business proposal identifying key growth areas on which they'd like to work.



In collaboration with the RAP's team, business proposals are presented to High Performing RAP organisations who choose to respond outlining how they can work with the FN organisation



RAP org business proposal response is shared with the FN organisation who then decides if they would like to enter into discussions on a potential partnership.

In this critical step, the power of self-determination sits firmly with the FN organisation.



Once both organisations are comfortable to move forward, the IGP team will make introductions and facilitate a 1-2 day workshop (to be held on Country) to discuss the partnering process.



Upon completion of the workshop, both parties may enter into a partnership/collaboration agreement



RA will support the relationship with periodical health checks for up to 2 years.
